Kobukai Guidelines

1. Aikido / Aikijujutsu is potentially a dangerous martial art and injuries can be possible - training should only be done in the company of a trained instructor.
2. Never do a technique that you feel uncomfortable or unable to perform - always seek your instructors or senior student's assistance before proceeding.
3. I agree to notify the club of any injury or discomfort caused by training.
4. I agree to notify the instructor or senior student of any changes to my health that might impact my ability to train.
5. No shoes or jewellery are permitted on the mat during class time.
6. Ensure you and your training uniform is clean, free of odours for every class, your finger and toes nails are not sharp (covered if long) existing cuts and abrasions are adequately protected and your hands and wrists have been washed.
7. Seek permission to enter or exit the mats or leave the premises once a class is in operation.
8. All children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by parent or guardian "to and from" the training premises.
9. No parents / guardians or other guests are permitted to enter the training area whilst a class is in operation.
10. I will not teach or attempt another school's techniques without expressed permission from the head instructor.
11. Any classes attended without an existing subscription package will be charged at \$15 per individual class.
12. Any member exceeding their subscription package allowance will be charged monthly for the extra classes as per the fee structure set out.
13. I understand the current fee structure does not cover the costs of any seminars or events - notification will be given for upcoming events.
14. Membership fees are inclusive of all subscription packages and all fees are based on an eleven-month cycle.
15. Uniforms can be purchased through the club; the beginner uniform is white and inclusive of the two club badges. Only senior grades are permitted to wear navy blue Keikogi.
