Kobukai Guidelines

1. Do you understand that Aikido / Aikijujutsu is potentially a dangerous martial art and injuries can occur, training should only be done in the company of a trained instructor.
2. Never do a technique that you feel uncomfortable or unable to perform, always seek your instructor or senior student’s assistance before proceeding.
3. I agree to notify the club of any injury or discomfort caused by training
4. I agree to notify the instructor or senior student of any changes on my health that might impact my ability to train.
5. Every student must “warm up” prior to training
6. No shoes or jewellery are permitted on the mat during class time.
7. Ensure you and your training uniform is clean, free of odours for every class, your finger and toes nails are not sharp (covered if long) existing cuts and abrasions are adequately protected and your hands and wrists have been washed.
8. Seek permission to enter or exit the mats or leave the premises once a class is in operation
9. I will not teach or attempt another school’s techniques without expressed permission from the head instructor
10. Any classes attended without an existing subscription package will be charged at \$15 per individual class.
11. I understand the current fee structure does not cover the costs of any seminars or events, notification will be given for upcoming events
12. Membership fees are inclusive and are based on an eleven-month cycle
13. Uniforms can be purchased through the club; the beginner uniform is white and includes the two club badges.
 Senior grades wear a blue keikogi, which is club embroidered and can only be purchased through the club.
